Background/Discussion:

The League of Arizona Cities and Towns has adopted a policy resolution supporting the appointment of a municipal representative to the Arizona State Liquor Board who would be focused on local concerns and issues. The League has asked for assistance in this endeavor from Arizona cities and towns. The proposed resolution supports the League policy resolution.

The League is also seeking qualified applicants to serve on the Arizona State Liquor Board and is asking for recommendations for this appointment. The Board typically meets on the first Thursday of every month, in Phoenix, with meetings starting at 10:00am. Board members may receive up to \$50 per day while conducting official business and are reimbursed for travel mileage. All candidates must have lived in Arizona for the last 5 years.
